

CALGARY HOUSING COMPANY — ACCESSIBLE UNIT EVALUATION FORM

In addition to filling out a Calgary Housing Company application form, applicants seeking units with enhanced accessibility are required to fill out the Accessible Unit Evaluation Form. Accessibility refers to the features of a unit that help someone with mobility challenges navigate their home. These units are best suited to individuals with physical disabilities and chronic health conditions. They are not intended for tenants with temporary injuries, such as a broken leg. If you are unsure of whether your situation is appropriate for accessible housing you may wish to consult with a physician or occupational therapist.

Level 1 – Level Access
