Calgary Housing Company has two different levels of accessible homes. Please review the information under each level and identify what your household needs. Please select the level of accessibility that best matches what you need:

Adaptable Home

- Close access for accessible vehicle drop-off and pick up near the entrance of the building (accessible vehicle access)
- No steps or limited steps at the building and home entrances
- Entryways, kitchen and bathroom design accommodates physical mobility devices
- Includes either a barrier-free kitchen or bathroom, but not both
- Some adaptable homes are fully designed for visual impairment, featuring upgraded lighting and color contrasted interior finishes and fixtures

*Adaptable homes are not suitable for full-time wheelchair users

Barrier-Free Home

- Close access for accessible vehicle drop-off and pick up near the entrance of the building (accessible vehicle access)
- Accessible parking stall
- Barrier-free path of travel to building and **home** entrance
- Lowered height of controls – light switches, thermostats, etc.
- Accommodate a 5-foot turning radius
- Bathrooms equipped with toilet space to accommodate transfer from mobility device

- Grab bars in bathroom (shower and toilet area)
- Bathtub or roll- in shower
- Kitchen accommodates mobility device, including food preparation, sink and cooking spaces
- Both kitchen and bathrooms include knee space
